Application for Classic Center Cultural Foundation 2010-2011 Scholarship

The Classic Center Cultural Foundation will be offering three separate \$1,000 scholarships. There will be one awarded for vocal performance, one for musical instrument and one for performance art: drama/dance. Any high school Junior or Senior from Clarke County or surrounding counties is eligible (Barrow, Jackson, Madison, Oconee and Oglethorpe). The Classic Center Cultural Foundation will also be awarding \$500 to the winning students' school. Please complete all sections of this application. Applications must be typed or neatly handwritten. Application deadline is **March 11, 2011 at 5:00PM**. This is a firm deadline and applications will not be accepted after that point. Previous CCCF scholarship recipients are not eligible. An audition will be required; it will be held on Monday, April 18, 2011, students will have an assigned time and they will begin at 5pm on the Classic Center theatre stage. Applicants should come prepared to audition on stage, with an audition that lasts no longer than four minutes. A piano and sound system will be provided. Qualifications for applicants are as follows:

1. Student must show a strong commitment to performing arts – drama, musical theatre, band or chorus and must be a high school junior or senior planning to attend a college or university.
2. Students must have an overall B average or above.
3. Student must demonstrate leadership qualities in school.
4. Students cannot be related to anyone employed by The Classic Center.
5. Student must perform at the audition.
6. Student must complete the application for the scholarship and submit it the Classic Center Cultural Foundation.
7. Student agrees to have his/her picture taken for use in possible promotional material for The Classic Center.
8. Student does not have to be majoring in performing arts in college.
